Best for: Obtaining the internationally recognised CTA designation while developing expert tax planning and advisory skills.

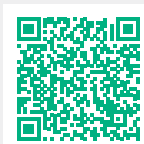

- ▶ GDATL – enrol concurrently and earn both qualifications by studying two additional electives.

Duration: 4 study periods.



Graduate Diploma of Applied Tax Law (GDATL)

Best for: Graduates looking to specialise in tax and working professionals looking to upskill or transition into a tax advisory role.

3 core subjects

Duration: 6 study periods.

Best for: Those looking to start or transition their career in tax and deepen their understanding of Australian Commercial Law.

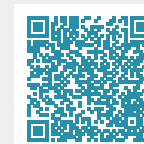

- ▶ GDATL – complete the additional two subjects: CTA2A and CTA2B Advanced.

Duration: 4 study periods.



Graduate Certificate in Applied Tax Advisory (GCATA)

Best for: Developing an in-depth knowledge of core tax issues and formalising your expertise in a specialised area of tax.

Pathway to:

- ▶ GDATL – by studying two additional electives.

Duration: 4 study periods.



Tax Agent Program

Best for: Professionals wanting to obtain the qualifications to register as a Tax Agent with the TPB, expanding career opportunities, and meeting growing industry demand.

6 core subjects



Pathway to:

- ▶ GDATL – enrol concurrently and earn both qualifications by completing the same subjects at no additional cost, provided candidates meet GDATL entry and TPB requirements.

Duration: 6 study periods.



Admission into these education programs and subjects is based on formal educational qualifications and at least twelve (12) months business experience in either tax, law, accounting or a combination thereof or twelve (12) months relevant business experience. CTA3 requires 36 months of Australian taxation experience.
