

During this time, Charl also presented at the Queensland Tax Researchers Symposium ("QTRS") in 2019 and was awarded the 'Best Abstract Award' for his article surrounding ESIC tax incentives and how this can be used to attract investment from Angel Investors.

He is also a member of the expert advisory panel to the Board of Taxation.
