Andi Lucas is the founder of X-Hemp Pty Ltd, which is Tasmania's only hemp fibre processing facility, one of a small handful currently operational in the country, and the only 100% female-owned and operated facility of this type in the world. In September 2022 she was elected as the president for the Tasmanian Hemp Association since. Alongside the other six elected Board Members, the association are focused on growing this nascent industry in Tasmania and mainland Australia, working closely with our many members - Grower, Corporate, Associate and Supporter - to represent their interests.
