Prof Julia Richardson is the Head of the School of Management and Marketing at Curtin University and an internationally recognised expert in Careers and Human Resources Management. She sits on the New Zealand Expert Business Performance Panel working with the NZ Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment. A former chair of the Careers Division and Member of Curtin University Council of the Academy of Management, Julia has enjoyed a global career in the private and public sectors in the UK, Singapore, Japan, Indonesia, New Zealand and Canada. She is also Associate Editor of two top tier academic journals and has won multiple awards for her research and teaching.

Professor Richardson's current research examines 'The future of careers', career sustainability, changing work practices and relationships, and work-life balance. Her work is regularly featured in local, national and international media and her co-authored book 'An Intelligent Career: Taking Ownership of Your Work and Your Life' (Oxford University Press) - published in English and Mandarin - has been ranked as a top resource for business executives. Her co-edited book 'New Ways of Working in a Changing World' (Routledge) examines the changing nature of work and work relationships and the implications for employees, management and public policy makers.
